



## KA1 Vortex DVS Senior Rok

Scott Sorensen continued his domination in the competitive KA1 Vortex DVS Senior Rok class, qualifying on pole and winning three of the four heat races. With inclement weather presenting before the final, the Harrington Doyle Racing team opted for a split strategy sending Sorensen out on wet tyres and teammate Luke Flynn on dry tyres. With the track drying throughout the race, Flynn manoeuvred his way to the front, greeting the chequered flag ahead of Thomas Steele, who passed Sorensen on the final lap for second. Sorensen wrapped up the KA1 Vortex DVS Senior Rok Championship with a 65 point advantage ahead of Reece Sidebottom and Thomas Steele.
